

FEES:

Classes:

\$24 each (\$8 x 3 judges) for PHBA classes or maximum fee of \$120 per horse for each day.

\$15 each (\$5 x 3 judges) for PHBA classes with horses age 2 and under

\$6 each for All Breed Classes (double judged)

Office:

\$24 (\$8 x 3 judges) per horse, per day for PHBA classes

\$5 per horse, per day for All Breed classes

Stalls:

\$60 for the weekend (3 nights)

\$12 for each additional night

\$25 for a day stall, if available

\$15 jump out fee if not using a stall

Shavings:

\$8 per bag. Please order ahead of time when you make your stall reservations.

Camping:

With electric hookup: \$30 per night

Without electric hookup: June show-no charge, August show \$25 per day

YOUTH SPECIAL

Class fees for Youth on Sunday will be \$0 as long as they have already shown in the same classes on Friday and Saturday. Must show on both previous days to qualify.

These rules are subject to change at any time up to and including the day of the show with or without further notice. Exhibitors and owners agree to abide by all the rules and regulations stated herein by signing the entry form. Any unsigned forms will not be accepted.

GENERAL RULES FOR ALL EXHIBITORS:

- ✓ PHBA Classes Are Triple Judged, All Breed classes are double judged.
- ✓ Current original negative Coggins and a copy for office required to show.
- ✓ WI requires 30-day interstate health papers on all out-of-state horses.
- ✓ Lunch stand on grounds
- ✓ Ribbons available for PHBA & All Breed classes for 1st - 6th place.
- ✓ Weekend Highpoints for PHBA classes and for All Breed classes.
- ✓ Daily Prize drawings for all exhibitors.
- ✓ All Breed classes are open to all breeds of equine and are sanctioned for the WI Horse Council Championship Challenge Program. Classes are also eligible for Palomino Performance Program (P3), if enrolled.
- ✓ All judges decisions are final.
- ✓ Refunds will only be given for scratches if office is notified at least 3 classes prior. The Show Manager reserves the right to combine, split or cancel any class in keeping with the shows best interest.
- ✓ Minors are not allowed to show stallions. A parent or guardian must sign the release form on the minor's entry sheet.
- ✓ Any exhibitor without a number or an incorrect number shall be disqualified.
- ✓ You may use your own back number if it is not already used by another exhibitor. Check with Show Secretary for number availability.
- ✓ A junior horse is 5 years of age or younger, a senior horse is 6 years or older for the performance classes, as of January 1 of the current year.
- ✓ No smoking or cooking is allowed in any of the buildings.
- ✓ All exhibitors have exactly 2 minutes to enter the ring once the class has been called and the gate is opened. No exhibitor shall be allowed in the ring once the gate is closed.
- ✓ A tack change must be requested at the gate at least 3 classes prior to the class in which the change is needed. A maximum of 3 minutes will be allowed after the tack change is announced.

INFORMATION FOR PHBA EXHIBITORS

- ✓ All PHBA exhibitors must have their original PHBA registration papers to verify current ownership of their horse and their PHBA membership cards at the show.
- ✓ Copies of the horse's PHBA registration papers, the Owner's current PHBA membership card and the Exhibitor's current PHBA membership card are to be submitted with the show entry form for the office to keep on file.
- ✓ To be eligible to compete in the Performance halter classes, a Register of Merit (ROM) must be earned and recorded on the horse's record. Proof of ROM must be provided to the Show Secretary and a copy of the ROM must be left with the show office.

INFORMATION FOR PEAW MEMBERS

- ✓ To qualify for PEAW year-end awards, Wisconsin members must meet ALL of the following requirements:
 - Exhibitor must complete a nomination form indicating which individual classes and/or division they want to compete in. Fees to nominate for complete divisions will be \$15, individual classes will be \$2 per class. Nominations must be made before entry into requested class.
 - There is a \$35 nomination fee for the year-end awards. This fee can be waived by volunteering for at least 4 hours at each show. Check in at the show office to see what volunteer opportunities are available.
 - Attend the Annual Meeting, in person, for each division you are nominating in.
- ✓ Year end awards are calculated on the same point system used for the weekend high points.
